

2014 OAKLAND DIOCESE CYO GIRLS' BASKETBALL PLAYOFFS FACT SHEET

1. **DATES:** The Oakland Diocese CYO Girls' Basketball Playoffs will be on Saturday and Sunday, May 17,18 with final games played on Monday and Tuesday, May 19, 20.
2. **TIMES/PLACES:** Games will be played at Moreau Catholic High School, 27170 Mission Blvd., Hayward; St. Joachim Gym, 21250 Hesperian Blvd., Hayward; St. Leo the Great Gym, 176 Ridgeway Ave., Oakland; St. Theresa Parish Event Center Gym, 4850 Clarewood Dr., Oakland. Times and assigned gyms are listed on the schedule. **READ SCHEDULE INFORMATION CAREFULLY!** Many games are played each day and we must stay as close to the schedule as possible. With this in mind, note that **GAME TIME IS FORFEIT TIME.**

Coaches are asked to check in at the gate before entering the gym.
3. **SINGLE ELIMINATION PLAYOFF:** This will be a single elimination playoff. Each league is to send their top two league finishers in grades 4, 5, 6, 7, 8.
4. **PLAYOFF SPORTSMANSHIP COMMITTEE:** This committee will be from members of the Diocesan Girls' CYO Athletic Council, selected athletic directors, league officers and coaches throughout the leagues. All protests will be decided "on-the-spot" by the gym director and members of this committee present.
5. **ADMISSION POLICY/ TEAM FEES:**

The Admission fee shall be:

Adults	\$3.00 (high school age and older)
Children	\$2.00 (elementary school through 8 th grade)
Free	Preschool; senior adults; participating coaches, coaching that day (on roster and their spouses); players (on roster, playing that day); clergy.

Team Fees: A \$60 playoff entry fee per team is charged.
6. **PROGRAMS/PLAYOFF T-SHIRTS:** Programs will be on sale for \$1.00 at the entry gates. Playoff T-Shirts may be purchased at the gates for \$10.00 each, while the supply lasts!
7. **AWARDS:** Each player will receive a certificate of participation and an award patch. For first and second place finishers in each grade, individual awards will be presented to each roster player. Each first and second place team will receive a team plaque and a banner for their school/parish.
8. **ELIGIBILITY:** All players who have been considered regular season members of their team, who meet the Diocesan Eligibility standards as described in the Diocesan CYO Bylaws, Article VI, and who are verified at the Coaches Playoff Meeting, are eligible to participate.
9. **OFFICIALS, TIMERS AND SCOREKEEPERS:** The top officials have been requested from each league. Referees, timers and scorers will be provided.
10. **PLAYOFF COACHES MEETING:** There will be a meeting of coaches participating in playoffs on **Tuesday, May 13, 7:00 p.m. at St. Leo the Great School Auditorium, 4238 Howe St., Oakland. At least the head coach or one assistant coach must represent each team at the meeting. Copies of the team roster, along with copies of proof of birth may be requested and must be brought to this meeting.** Proof of birth may not be accepted after this meeting. Each team will be checked and cleared or disqualified at this meeting. Coaches will be asked to present their 2013–2014 CYO Coaches Certification Card. *The \$60 per team playoff entry fee is due at this meeting.*

11. **CYO RULES:** The 2013–2014 National Federation of State High School Association Basketball Rulebook will be the official rulebook with the Diocesan CYO Bylaws and these exceptions:
- Time** – 4th, 5th and 6th grades will play 6-minute quarters, "stopped clock." 7th and 8th grades will play 7-minute quarters, "stopped clock." There may be seven minutes between halves.
 - Press Rule** – As in the Diocesan CYO Bylaws with the exception of the 4th grade as described below. The diocesan rule of 10 point no press in the 5th grade and 15 points in the 6th, 7th and 8th grades will be in effect.
 - 4th Grade Press Rule** – In 4th grade (only), no press will be allowed by the defensive team until the offensive player and the ball are allowed to cross the half court line. Full court press will be allowed in the last minute in regulation time or in each overtime (unless the defensive team is ahead by 10 or more points).
 - 4TH Grade Free Throw** – In 4th grade (only), the free-throw shooter may cross the free throw line as long as she makes no attempt to approach the basket prior to the ball hitting the rim or backboard.
 - Overtime rule** – As in the Diocesan CYO Bylaws.
 - Coaches Crowd Control Responsibility** – Coaches are responsible for the behavior of their own spectators, as in the Diocesan CYO Bylaws.
 - Choice of Ball** – A game ball will be provided.
 - All Play Rule (May Be Different from your League Rule)** – As in the Diocesan CYO Bylaws with the exception that the **first three** quarters will be split into playing periods. The **first and second entry** of each player must be at the **beginning** of a playing period and she must play those entire periods (except for injury or disqualification). A player may not enter as a substitute in the middle of a playing period unless she has completed both of her playing periods and substitutes for a player who as also competed her playing periods. There shall be NO penalty for the late child to the game. She shall be allowed to play as long as there is the equivalent time of a playing period remaining in regulation time.
 - Timeouts** – There will be four, one-minute timeouts per team in a regulation game. There is one additional one-minute timeout per team per overtime period.
 - Uniform** – T-shirts worn underneath the jersey and tight shorts extending below the bottom of the uniform shorts must match the primary color of the uniform. The referee may permit other colors of T-shirts to be worn for reasons of modesty. Shirts should be tucked in and pants worn above the hip as per NF rules.
 - Coaches' Box** – There is no coaches' box. Coaches must remain seated on the bench except in the instances in the NF Rulebook, Rule 10-5.
 - Three Point Shot** – The three point shot will be used in the 8th grade only.
 - Prayer** – The home team will be responsible for leading a prayer before each game.

12. **OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION:**

- NO PERSON SHALL BE ALLOWED IN A LOCKER ROOM WITHOUT A COACH PRESENT. TEAMS VIOLATING THIS RULE WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN LOCKER ROOMS!**
- No FOOD OR DRINKS are allowed in the gym at Moreau except in the designated area.
- Snack bars will be open at each facility.
- Coaches **MUST** carry their medical authorization forms with them.
- REMAND YOUR PARENTS TO SUPERVISE THEIR CHILDREN, ESPECIALLY YOUNGER CHILDREN AT THE GYMS. CHILDREN SHOULD NOT BE SENT OUTSIDE TO PLAY!**
- ONLY PLAYERS AND CERTIFIED COACHES WILL BE ALLOWED TO SIT ON THE BENCH DURING THE GAMES. ONLY DIOCESAN-ASSIGNED SCORERS AND TIMERS WILL BE ALLOWED AT THE OFFICIAL SCORERS TABLE.**

THE PURPOSE OF BASKETBALL PLAYOFFS IS TO PROVIDE A QUALITY SPORTS EXPERIENCE FOR OUR YOUTH AND TO PROMOTE A CHRISTIAN ATMOSPHERE OF FRIENDSHIP AMONG ALL PLAYERS, COACHES, TEAMS, OFFICIALS AND FANS. YOUR COOPERATION AS A CHRISTIAN ROLE MODEL AND A POSITIVE INFLUENCE FOR ALL YOUTH IS EXPECTED AND ENCOURAGED. THIS IS NOT THE WNBA PLAYOFFS NOR THE WOMEN'S FINAL FOUR – REMEMBER: "THEY'RE JUST KIDS!"
