**Overview**

Cristo Rey De La Salle East Bay High School is seeking an a **Temporary Math Team-Educator** for its Lasallian Catholic, co-educational, secondary school which opened in June of 2018 on the campus formerly home to Saint Elizabeth High School. The school is sponsored by the De La Salle Christian Brothers, District of San Francisco New Orleans.

Cristo Rey De La Salle East Bay High School (in the heart of Oakland's historic Fruitvale district on the St. Elizabeth Campus) partners with East Bay families of limited means to provide their student a unique opportunity to receive a holistic education and become students in service of others. Through a rigorous curriculum built around personalized learning, professional work experience, and the centuries old Lasallian tradition of providing transformational education to those most in need, Cristo Rey De La Salle students graduate prepared to thrive in college and compete in a rapidly developing world.

CRDLS uses the Corporate Work Study Program (CWSP) modeled after the successful programs at 32 Cristo Rey Network schools. All students are required to complete a college preparatory curriculum and participate in the Work Study Program. Under the Corporate Work Study Program, each student is employed five days per month by a local business or community agency to provide tuition assistance and complement the school's on-site curricular program. The school is currently participating in the Replication Process of the Cristo Rey Network.

**Our Mission**

Cristo Rey De La Salle East Bay High School, St. Elizabeth Campus, is a diverse, Lasallian Catholic learning community that educates young people of limited economic means to become men and women of faith, purpose, and service. A rigorous and personalized college preparatory curriculum integrated with a corporate work study experience prepares students to succeed in college and in life.

**Job Description Overview**

Team Educators (TEs) are a valuable part of the Teach to One (TTO) model. Their presence is critical to successful implementation. The primary distinction between TEs and core program teachers is that TEs are not typically scheduled for teacher-led modalities, such as Tasks or Live Investigations. TEs are also not responsible for a Math Advisory cohort. Like program teachers, TEs need appropriate mathematical content knowledge, classroom management and professional skills. Thus, their involvement in trainings,



common planning sessions and professional learning communities is highly imperative to maintaining program integrity—specifically in independent and collaborative learning zones.

**Daily Responsibilities:**

- Participate in teacher trainings and common planning sessions
- Check teaching schedule and plan appropriately for teaching, typically:
  - Collaborative Modalities (Small Group Collaboration and Peer to Peer Collaboration)
  - Independent Learning Modalities (Virtual Instruction, Virtual Reinforcement, and Independent Practice)
- Take attendance and score student Work Ethic and Contribution in sessions.
- Develop teaching skills in assigned modalities as defined by TTO rubrics and coached by school-based Assistant Principal and TTO instructional coach.
- Other professional responsibilities as defined by Assistant Principal.
- RBOs (Relationship building opportunities) - Supervision before school and after school.

**Who is encouraged to apply:**

- Student teachers (MUST be available for program sessions regardless of college/university schedule).
- PT teachers working at another school site (must be available on dates listed below)
- Retired teachers

**Requirements for applying:**

At least a BA degree (desire: focus in Mathematics)

Experience working with high school students

Experience working with a diverse student body

The Team-Educator must be available on **Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 7:45 to 4:30pm.**

**Compensation:**

Depending on experience and Daily Substitute Rate.
